France's young people are discovering vocational apprenticeships. The youth unemployment figures have recently improved significantly. Apprenticeships are not only more actively promoted, but also subsidised by the state: The minimum wage has been raised and the apprentice can expect a subsidy for the driving licence. Since the first pandemic summer of 2020, companies have received up to 8000 euros a year from the state if they take on an apprentice.
