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### European Commission

On 1 January 2025, Poland took over the six-month presidency of the Council of the EU. Regarding vocational education and training, the Polish Presidency will continue work on the implementation of the concept of vocational excellence.

It will also form, together with Denmark and Cyprus, who will then assume the presidency, the so-called trio of presidencies for the next 18 months. These three countries create their common programme which emphasizes security, democratic values and sustainable competitiveness.

US President Donald Trump signs decrees that will directly or indirectly affect research and education policy: Measures to support disadvantaged populations in education and to promote relevant colleges and universities for these minorities have been withdrawn. New guidelines for the use of federal funds at colleges and educational institutions have been announced. All Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) programs in government agencies and federal agencies are being discontinued. The Stargate AI infrastructure project has been announced. A joint venture of companies like Oracle, OpenAI, MGX, and SoftBank has pledged investments of approximately €481 billion over the next four years. A primary focus will be on using AI for healthcare. An executive order on the development of safe and trustworthy Artificial Intelligence (AI) has been declared invalid. Withdrawals from the Paris Agreement on climate change and the WHO also have direct implications for research.
