### **European Parliament**

Danish Presidency debriefs EP committees on priorities. For the Culture and Education Committee Mattias Tesfaye, Minister for Education and Youth, said that the Presidency wanted to make vocational education and training more attractive, ensure learning mobility, and focus on how the digitalisation affects learning outcomes. The Presidency will also prioritise negotiations on the next generation of Erasmus+ and on the European education area. The Employment and Social Affairs Committee stressed that the Presidency would focus on investing in skills, fair labour mobility, strengthening social dialogue, and occupational health.

# **European Commission and Parliament**

The Commission has put forward a proposal for a strengthened Erasmus+ programme for the period 2028-2034. The proposed programme will support learning mobility from an early age and capacity building in education, training, youth and sport.

The proposed Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) for the EU budget 2028-34 strives to foster education and democratic values e.g. by investment in skills.

The Erasmus+ programme will be reinforced: In order to reflect the key features of the new MFF, which is designed to give Europe the flexibility to act and react quickly when circumstances change unexpectedly or new policy priorities arise, there will no longer be any earmarking of funding for VET mobility. This means that the Commission will be able to vary the funding for VET mobility on an annual basis.

Furthermore, the commission proposed a new programme to support Culture, Media and Union values: the AgoraEU programme will promote shared values, including democracy, equality and the rule of law and support the European cultural diversity, its audiovisual and creative sectors, media freedom and civil society involvement.

In the academic year beginning on 1 September 2025, amendments to the Vocational Training Institutions Act will come into force, affecting free and fee-based study at state and municipal vocational training institutions.
